

Air Belgium to offer direct flights to Dominican Republic from Brussels Airport

Mont-Saint-Guibert - 15 December 2021. The airline will launch scheduled air services to Punta Cana from mid-December.

The Belgian airline, Air Belgium, will officially launch on 15 December direct and regular flights to Punta Cana in Dominican Republic from Brussels Airport (Zaventem).

After the successful launch of a first route from Brussels Airport to Mauritius, Air Belgium will now also offer two weekly direct flights to Punta Cana every Wednesday and Saturday.

Travellers will also be able to fly to Curacao on the same route on Wednesdays and Saturdays after a short stopover in Punta Cana.
